SUBJECT: OPERATION ADVANCE MAN
SECURITY MATTER

We need more men. Earlier assessments of the threat were incorrect, and the team believes now it is dealing with more than one assailant. Of the eighteen missing locals, nine have been confirmed dead (see attached report) and three are suspected of having joined the enemy.

Since the mound was disturbed on November 10, 1954, the town of [redacted] has averaged one disappearance every other day and press inquiries are becoming onerous and difficult to stop. Initial investigation by agents on scene. Since then-

-dominated by three possible factions. In the classic all three of these forces (as seen in recoveries from LOVETT (see 3.1), GREEN (see 5.5) and KILARNEY (see 11.9.1)) are to be considered "non-human terrestrial threats", though the recovery of the Lovett humanoid does t such the three theories into disarray. But for the purposes of this document the three forces are designated the following:

- a. MOUND-BUILDERS: A significant threat in America for the last 180+ years, these non-human but humanoid giants (first specimen killed by Lovett in 1949) superficially appear to be related to humans, or more to the point, WE appear to be descendants of THEM. Reports on size varies from as 8 feet to as tall as 21 feet tall. It is widely thought these beings pre-date modern humans, and may perhaps be a distant ancestor with a much deeper history and timeline than anything considered "ancient" by human standards. Certainly, their ability to manipulate hypergeometric forces are formidable. It is currently believed by learning group TOPSOIL that these beings are the source of ancient American Indian stories that these Giants" that enslaved, hunted, warred and ate the ancient human tribes of the Americas. They are known to be connected to the ancient mounds of the American middle west. Apparently, these beings still exist in some removed locale within the Earth, and work together in concert to enact their plans which are, for the most part, inscrutable and unknown.

b. REPTILIAN HUMANOIDS: Considered a much older threat, the group has dealt with this kind of being on two-dozen occasions all around the world since 1928. Ancient, immortal creatures more akin to warm-blooded reptiles than anything mammalian, these beings nevertheless possess incredible intelligence, as well as potent hypergeometric knowledge. Solitary and eager to remain hidden, the reptilian humanoids can appear as a normal human at will, through some unknown process which may be psychological in nature (untested). These beings appear to be much less populous than the Mound-Builders. Their long-term plans remain unknown.

c. TERRESTRIALLY ASYNCHRONOUS BEINGS: A conglomeration of reports from all corners of North America dating back to colonial times indicate the presence of beings that conterminously exist in our time/space as well as elsewhere (theories include other realities, bi-location, or merely slipping between static points in time/space while skipping other points). Glowing, flying beings that vanish, pass through objects and communicate with a buzzing hum are reported so many times in fringe American history that few in the assessment group TOPSOIL doubt such creatures haunt the periphery of reality. Twice these beings have been "killed", though their remains dissolved in under an hour, leaving nothing behind to be studied. It is widely thought the non-terrestrial device code-named TRIGGER was manufactured by such beings (see 22.1).

RECOVERY AND COVER-UP

A successful campaign to cover-up the presence of the Mound-Builders has been employed for as long as this country has existed. The Smithsonian special collection (hidden from the public and classified) contains over 300+ skeletons, skulls, and artifacts of the Mound-Builder giants, leaving little doubt of their physical existence. From time to time new burial chambers are discovered, and covered-up; the last in Death Valley in 1956 (see 25.8.1).

The other two types of threats (b and c) remain so limited in population that each encounter should be reported immediately and countermeasures should be detailed on a per-operation basis.
